PREAMBLE

The M.A.Rangoonwala College of Dental Sciences & Research Centre is situated at Pune. It is recognized college by the Government of India. It is permitted by the State Government & is affiliated to the Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik it is situated in the Cantonment Area of Pune City. This College is part of a huge campus where several professional & other colleges are situated.

The Central Govt after satisfying that M.A.Rangoonwala College of Dental Sciences and Research Centre has full infrastructure including required furniture, fixture, equipment & machinery and fully qualified faculty, has recognized our College.

After recognition by the Central Govt. the Management of the College decide to start Post Graduate course in all the 9 subjects. However, the Dental council of India, New Delhi, has recommended to the Central Govt, the MDS course in the following 8 subjects.

The Government of India had sanctioned the intake capacity vide its letter dt 02/03/2009 No.V2017/19/2006 DE,

The College is a Muslim Minority Educational Institute & recognized by the State Govt. as such. Out of 25 seats 15% seats will be reserved for NRI candidates, out of remaining seats 60% seats shall be reserved for Muslim candidates and remaining 40% seats shall be reserved for Non-Muslim Candidates.

In case sufficient number of Muslim candidates are not available , then such seats shall be allotted to the Non-Muslim candidates. Likewise if sufficient number of Non-Muslim candidates are not available then such seats will be allotted to the Muslim candidates.

FEES

Fees Rs.3 Lacs for each course will be charged per annum. Fee will be payable as per sanction of the Shikshan Shulk Samiti Mumbai.

The MDS course admission shall be carried out as per law laid down in TMA PAI Foundation case judgment as interpreted in Islamic Academic case & in the case of P.A. Inamdar by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India. The management has decided to admit Muslim, Non Muslim candidates as permitted under the P.A. Inamdar judgment 15% of the seats will be reserved for NRI quota candidates.

The admission through MARDC-PGAICET 2010 shall be for Minority & Non-Minority Candidates .Foreign Muslim students are included in Muslim Quota and they have to appear for MARDC-PGAICET 2010. N.R.I students need not go through CET, however admission in N.R.I Quota shall be on inter se merit.

MARDC- Post Graduate All India Common Entrance Test 2010 will be in the form of multiple- choice question. The admission will be on the inter-se-merit in this Entrance Test 2010.

This brochure for MARDC-PGAICET 2010 contains single application form for Entrance examination. It also contains Rules for admission, process of Selection etc. These Rules are applicable only for Academic Year 2010-2011.

2. DEFINITIONS:

1) COMPETENT AUTHORITY:

The competent authority is an authority appointed by the college to conduct MARDC-PGAICET 2010, declare the result, supervise and control the selection process. The competent authority will issue necessary instruction for execution of these rules & provide relevant information to be published & communicated. The Competent Authority shall consists of Chairman & two members, who are

1. Dr. R.D.Joseph, Chairman
2. Dr.T.A.Bilgrami, Gen. Secretary
3. Dr. Bhushan Patil

II) Dental Council of India (DCI) means the Dental Council of India established under Dentist Act, 1948.

III) "Courses" means 3 years Post BDS degree course leading to MDs degree in various subjects.

IV) "Internship" means the compulsory rotating internship to be completed as per rules of Dental Council of India (DCI) and Maharashtra State Dental Council (MSDC) & concerned University.

V) "Recognized Qualification" means the qualification recognized by the Dental Council of India (DCI) & the University in India.

VI) "Registration" means the registration of qualification either with the DCI, MSDC, or other such authority in respective states/countries after competing one year compulsory rotating internship.

VII) "Post graduate Teacher" means the post graduate teacher who is recognized as a teacher under the regulation of the Dental Council of India (DCI), by Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik or other universities.

VII) "University" means the non-agricultural university constituted under the Maharashtra University Act, 1994 or by MUHS Act 1998 & other universities.

3. NUMBER OF SEATS AND LIST OF POST – GRADUATE COURSES

The list of Post graduate (MDS) courses available & the Number of Seats in M.A.Rangoonwala College of Dental Sciences & Research Centre, Pune are mentioned here in above.

4. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA :

4.1 Candidate must be an Indian National. Nationality certificate issued by the District Magistrate or additional District Magistrate of Chief Metropolitan Magistrate? Valid Passport shall constitute the proof of Nationality. However, it is not applicable to the NRI candidates and foreign national Candidates.

4.2 A candidates who has passes final BDS examination from a recognized Dental college included in the schedule of the Indian Dentist Act, 1993 or such other equivalent and who has obtained full registration either from the Dental Council of India or State Dental Council or Dental Council or such other body in that country after competing one- year compulsory rotating internship will be eligible to appear for MARDC-PGAICET 2010. Registration is a condition precedent for appearing at MARDC-PGAICET 2010 for Post Graduate Degree Courses.

4.3 The Full/permanent DCI/MDC or equivalent registration is a condition precedent for appearing at MARDC-PGAICET 2010 and its proof including submission of application for registration should be enclosed.

- 4.4 A candidate who has completed one year compulsory Internship or is likely to complete the same on or before 31/03/2010 can appear for MARDC- PGAICET 2010.
- 4.5 Candidate likely to complete their internship on or before 31/3/2010 should submit documentary proof from their Principals/Dean of the college regarding the likely date of completion of internship.
- 4.6 Candidates who are previously registered and pursuing/ completed the course is not eligible for appearing at MARDC – PGAICET 2010. Candidates who have completed PG Diploma is eligible to appear for the MARDC – PGAICET 2010 For admission to PG degree in the same subject only.

5. CANDIDATES NOT ELIGIBLE FOR APPEARING:

- 5.1 Candidates who are not completing internship on or before 31/3/2010.
- 5.2 Candidates who are registered for PG Degree/ Diploma and have not completed the terms.
- 5.3 Candidates who have NOT obtained permanent DCI/Sate or other countries DC registration at the time of submission of application form except those who will be completing internship by 31/3/2010
- 5.4 Candidates who are previously registered and pursuing/ completed the PG degree courses or have obtained PG degree.

6. APPLICATION PROCEDURE:

- 6.1 An applicant seeking admission to the MARDC – PGAICET 2010 will be required to submit single prescribed Application Form, which can be obtained from office of the M. A. Rangoonwala Dental College, Pune.
- 6.2 Information Brochure along with blank Application Form will be available at the office of the M.A. Rangoonwala Dental College at Pune on payment of prescribed fees of Rs. 1500 By DD drawn in favour of “M.A. Rangoonwala College of Dental Sciences & Research Centre” payable at Pune drawn on a Nationalised/Scheduled Bank.
- 6.3 The All India Common Entrance Test fees for MARDC – PGAICET 2010 is Rs 1500 which shall be paid by DD in favour of M.A. Rangoonwala College of Dental Sciences & Research Centre payable at Pune drawn on a Nationalised / Scheduled Bank at the time of submission of application form.
- 6.4 MARDC – PGAICET 2010 will be conducted only at Pune at M. A. Rangoonwala College of Dental Sciences & Research Centre Pune.

- 6.5 No original documents to be attached with the application form.
- 6.6 Candidate should fill the Application Form in his/her own hand writing and submit within specified date.

7. ADMIT CARD

- 7.1 The Admit card will be sent by Speed Post/ Courier or will be issued in person to candidate between 06-01-2010 to 14-02-2010 In case the candidate do not receive the admit card 10-02-2010 he/she should contact M. A. Rangoonwala Dental College, Pune immediately for duplicate admit card.
- 7.2 Issue of admit card is just an enabling provision for appearing MARDC – PGAICET 2010 and does not imply that the candidate satisfies all the requirements of eligibility conditions of admission.
- 7.3 In case of loss of admit card, it shall be obligatory on the part of candidate to procure duplicate Admit card by paying fee of Rs. 100/- from the office of the Examination Centre Incharge one hour before the Commencement of examination on production of receipt – cum – identity card or sufficient evidence to prove that he/she is the genuine examinee

8. CONDUCT OF MARDC – PGAICET 2010.

- 8.1 All the eligible candidates are required to take the MARDC – PGAICET 2010 at their own cost.
- 8.2 The MARDC – PGAICET 2010 will be conducted on Sunday 14-02-2010 between 1.30 p.m. to 3.30 p.m.
- 8.3 The MARDC – PGAICET 2010 will be conducted only at M. A. Rangoonwala College of Dental Sciences & Research Centre Pune.
- 8.4 The examination will be conducted in English.
- 8.5 MARDC – PGAICET 2010 paper will be of one and half hours duration containing 100 multiple – choice questions (MCQ).
Questions will be of single best response objective type with four answer options. Each correct response shall be awarded one mark. There shall be no negative marking for wrong answers. Scratching, overwriting, tick mark and multiple answers will be considered as wrong answers and no marks will be awarded to them.
- 8.6 The All India Common Entrance Test shall be of the standard of BDS Examination and shall cover all the subjects of BDS Course. The tentative number of questions of each subject will be as given below:

9. RESULT AND MERIT LIST:

- 9.1 The Competent Authority shall conduct MARDC – PGAICET 2010, get the answer sheets evaluated and prepare the Merit list.
- 9.2 The Merit list will be available on M. A. Rangoonwala Dental College website as per schedule.
- 9.3 The statement of marks of the candidate indicating marks obtained and merit number of the candidate will be dispatched by Post.
- 9.4 The candidate who wants duplicate mark sheet will have to apply to the Competent Authority with prescribed fees of Rs. 500/- (Rupees Five Hundred only) paid by D.D drawn in favour of “ M. A. Rangoonwala College of Dental Sciences & Research Centre payable at Pune.
- 9.5 There will be no rechecking /revaluation of the answer sheets. However the candidate can apply for verification of marks to the Competent Authority MARDC – PGAICET 2010 directly within Three day’s of declaration of result in the prescribed form (Annexure “A”) along with prescribed fees of Rs. 1,000/ - (Rupees One Thousand Only) to be paid by Demand Draft in favour of M.A. Rangoonwala College of Dental Sciences & Research Centre payable at Pune. The candidate will be given photocopy of the answer sheet and model answer key after verification by the Competent Authority.

10. TIE - BREAKER:

- 10.1 Determination of the Inter – se merit of candidate obtaining equal MARDC- PGAICET 2010 marks. In case of two or more candidates obtaining equal marks in the MARDC – PGAICET 2009 the inter – se merit of such candidates will be determined in the order of preference as under:
 - 10.1.1 The candidate with higher aggregate marks (converted into percentage) at First, Second, Third and Final BDS Examination (Part I & II) taken together shall be preferred, if the tie still persists-

- 10.1.2 The candidate with higher aggregate marks (converted into percentage) at Final BDS Examination (Part I & II) will be preferred, if the tie still persists-
- 10.1.3 The candidate with higher aggregate marks (converted into percentage) at Third BDS Examination will be preferred, if the tie still persists-
- 10.1.4 The candidate with higher aggregate marks (converted into percentage) at Second BDS Examination will be preferred, if the tie still persists-
- 10.1.5 An older candidate will be preferred over a younger candidate.
- 10.1.6 While considering I,II, III & final BDS marks & aggregate for above purpose, grace & or NSS marks not to be taken into account.
11. In case of any typographical error in mark sheet e.g. name, age, sex, category etc. representation should be submitted within 24 hours from the date of distribution of mark sheet to the Competent Authority.

12. SELECTION PROCESS

- 12.1 The selection to a Course will be made as per Merit – Cum – Preference given by the candidate.
- 12.2 The Preference form shall be given to the candidates immediately after the MARDC – PGAICET 2010 is over at the examination Centre itself.
- 12.3 Eligible candidates from MARDC – PGAICET 2010 Merit List will be required to fill in the “Preference form”. Only one preference form should be submitted directly to the office of the Rangoonwala Dental College on or before 14/02/2010 Preference form received after this date will not be considered. The Preference filled by the candidates will be centrally processed and the final merit list prepared. As per the Merit – cum – Preference the selection to be made and the list of selected candidates will be declared on the Website of Rangoonwala Dental College. As per the declared Selection List the candidates should report to the College and join within the specified period.
- 12.4 The list of subjects will be provided with the Preference Form.
- 12.5 Candidate should write subject of Preference in the boxes.
- 12.6 If a candidate does not give Preference for a particular subject then it means that he/she is not interested in those subjects. Candidates should note that there will be No Change/Addition/Deletion in the preference at a later stage.
- 12.7 The Candidate selected as per his/her Merit cum Preference for a particular subject, then he/she has to join the courses as per procedure. In failure to join the allotted course in the stipulated time, he/she is debarred from subsequent admission process of MARDC – PGAICET 2010.

- 12.8 In case the candidate is not selected in the first round, then he/she remains eligible for the subsequent round for the preferences, which he/she has given in the Preference Form.
- 12.9 For filling of vacant seats after round same Preference Form will be considered and no separate Preference Form will be required to be filled in by the candidates.
- 12.10 Candidate should submit only one Preference Form Submission of more than one Preference will be lead to disqualification.

13. SELECTION PROCEDURE:

- 13.1 The collected data will be centrally processed for the selection of candidates for Post Graduates Dental College Courses (MDS)
- 13.2 The Selection will be done as per Merit and Preference given by candidates in Preference Form.
- 13.3 The list of candidate selected for Post Graduate Dental Courses shall be displayed on the M.A.Rangoonwala College of Dental Sciences & Research Centre website www.mardentalcollege.org
- 13.4 The First Selection list will be declared on 28/02/2010 on the college website. Candidates should report and pay the fees and submit all the original certificates with one set of attested Xerox copies of all the certificates, at the College office on or before 28/02/2010. No separate selection letter will be issued to the selected candidates.
- 13.5 If the Candidates does not report within this date, his /her selection stands cancelled and will be debarred from the subsequent process.
- 13.6 The following Candidates will not be eligible for subsequent admission process.
- 13.6.1 Accepting registration but not reporting to the college and /or not paying the fees.
- 13.6.2 Reporting to the College Not attending the residency program regularly.
- 13.6.3 Unauthorized absence during the residency.
- 13.6.4 Paying the fees but not attending the residency
- 13.6.5 If the admission given by the Competent Authority is cancelled by the Principal as a disciplinary action /defaulter.
- 13.6.6 If Post-Graduate registration given by the Competent Authority is cancelled by the candidate.

FILLING VACANT SEATS:

- 13.7 After selection in first round the vacant seats, if any, will be filled up by selection on or before 31/05/2010 by declaring the selection list on the college Notice Board. Selected candidates will report to the college on or before 31/05/2010.

- 13.8 Any seat remaining vacant after the second round of admission will be filled –in by the college by inviting applications from the eligible candidates by giving advertisement in news papers.
- 13.9 The last date of admission process for filling vacant seats for Post Graduate Dental Courses is 31/05/2010.
- 13.10. The candidates must produce original certificates at the time of admission and a set of attested photocopy of each of the documents as per the list given below.
- Attested photocopy of filled in Application Form.
 - Attested Photocopy of filled in preference Form.
 - Nationality Certificate of Valid Passport.
 - Proof of Age.
 - Statement of BDS marks of First Year, Second year, Third year and Final year (Part I and part II)
 - BDS Degree /Passing Certificate
 - Attempt Certificate of all University Examinations.
 - Internship Completion Certificate or Certificate indicating the likely date of completion of Internship.
 - Registration Certificate of State Council /DCI or equivalent Councils.
- 13.11 canvassing directly or indirectly for the allotment of seat would disqualify the candidate's admission. Influencing the staff by unfair means will lead to cancellation of allotted seat and such candidates will also face disqualification for appearance in the subsequent MARDC-PGAICET Examinations.
- 13.12 The registration once granted is valid only if the teacher and the principal are satisfied about regularity, diligent persuasion of studies by the student as well as good conduct .
- 13.13 Candidates selected for admission shall be subject to disciplinary rules of University / Institution /Government and Management.
- 13.14. A candidate selected for Post-Graduate Degree course will not be allowed for change of subject.
- 13.15. In case of dispute in the matter of allotment of seat/ course or any other matter pertaining to the provisional selection or cancellation of admission, the decision of the management of the concerned institution shall be final and binding.
- 13.16 Candidate who has confirmed his/ her admission may cancel it by submitting an application to the Principal.

14. THE PROCEDURE FOR CANCELLATION:

- 14.1 Candidates canceling his/her admission on or before 31-05-2010 will be eligible for subsequent MARDC-PGAICET 2011.
- 14.2. Candidate canceling his/ her admission after 31-05-2010 will not be eligible for subsequent two years of MARDC-PGAICET.

15. REFUND OF FEES

- 15.1 As per the direction issued from the Pravesh Niyamtran Samiti it has been decided that if a seat is filled in and there is no vacant seat remain to be filled in by the College / Institute in such a case the College / Institute should deduct only up to Rs.1, 000/- and balance amount of fees paid by a student should be refunded, otherwise the same amount to profiteering and charging of capitation fees. The Samiti further directs that the College/ Institute should also return the original documents such as mark list etc.collected from the students.

15.2 If a candidates expires or becomes invalid within three month from the date of admission, full refund shall be made after deducting Rs.1,000/- as administrative charges.

15.3 After prescribed date No refund shall be made.

16. DISCIPLINE:

16.1 Any candidates / authorized representative or accompanying person is found obstructing the admission process, trying to influence in unlawful manner/creating nuisance, the candidate shall be liable for disqualification from the process of selection. The decision taken by the Management in this respect shall be final and binding.

16.2 All candidates selected shall be subject to the disciplinary rules of the institution, University, Government and Management .

17. UNDERTAKING AND BOND:

Candidates selected for Postgraduate Dental Course will be required to give a bond of Rs.Five Lakhs supported by two sureties to serve the institution for a period of 3 years. If the candidates fails to render the services as stipulated above the amount noted in the bond will be recovered.

18. LEGAL JURISDICTION:

All disputes pertaining to the conduct of examination and selection process shall fall within the jurisdiction of Mumbai High Court bench at Mumbai only or fo the legal jurisdiction of the institution concerned.

19. DISQUALIFICATION FOR ADMISSION:

Any candidates himself or his Authorized proxy if found obstruction the admission process or trying to influence it by unlawful manner or creating nuisance the candidate shall be liable for disqualification from the admission process. The decision taken by the principal shall be final and binding.

20. Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik shall take the decision regarding granting of the eligibility of selected candidates.

21. CONDUCT AND DISIPLINE

21.1 The students while studying in the Health Sciences Course if found indulging in anti national activities, unlawful activities or ragging in any form, contrary to the provision s of Acts and Law enacted by the Government, will be liable to be expelled from the college by the Principal of the College.

21.2 Failure of the candidates in making full and correct statements in the application form and /or suppression of any information will be liable for disqualification of the candidate at later sate. Such a candidates will be debarred from the entire selection process and pursuing the course of studies.

21.3 It is responsibility of every candidate to submit proper documents. Any attempt to submit documents, which are not genuine, will lead to cancellation of the admission of the candidate, forfeiture of the fees, deposits and expulsion of the candidates from the college by the competent authority of by his authorized official. The name of such candidates shall be deleted from the Merit list and he/ she will not be eligible for further rounds of the selection process and will be debarred from the selection process. If deemed fit even criminal proceeding may be initiated by the Competent Authority of his authorized official against such candidates their parent

21.4 RAGGING BAN

Pursuant to the order in W.P (Civil) No.656 of 1999, Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, has directed the Department of Human Recourses Development and Education Govt. of India to take all necessary steps to curb the menace of ragging and take severe action against the students involved in such activities. These guidelines are strictly implemented for last 5 years in this institution, as a result no incidences of ragging is reported.

21.5 As per the provision of Maharashtra act xxxiii known as "Maharashtra prohibition of ragging act of 1999" students indulging in ragging can be punished under the Act resulting in suspension , expulsion from the college and imprisonment.

21.6 Any issue not dealt here in above will be dealt with, when arising, fully and finally by the competent authority.

22. INSURANCE

Inacordance with GR.No.MED-100/880/CR-123/EDU-1, dated 23/10/2003 " Amartya Shisha Yojana" , as insurance scheme has been introduces by Govt. of Maharashtra. The details about this scheme shall be known to the candidates at the time of admission.
